

Dear Patient,

Below is a list of medications that will interfere with allergy testing. Due to new medications being introduced on the market, there is always a chance that something you may have taken will not be on this list. As a general rule of thumb, please do not take anything that contains **anti-histamines**, **brompheniramines**, **chlorpheniramines**, **diphenhydramines**, or states, **allergies**, **cold**, **nighttime**, or **PM**, **FOUR** days prior to your allergy testing, whether it is prescription or over the counter. Some medications take 10 days to 2 weeks to get out of your system and will be noted as such.
